Please take the time to read the following:

- Entries are £12.00 per class.
- No entries will be taken on the day except for the Puissance Class.
- Numbers will be available on the day.
- The judges decision is final.
- All ages are taken from the 1st January of the current year.
- No refunds will be made for missed or cancelled classes except at the Show Organisers discretion.
- Discourtesy to Judges, Stewards or Classics officials will not be tolerated and the Organisers will take action against any person(s) concerned.
- Complaints must be made in writing and handed to the show organisers within 15 mins of the class finishing along with a deposit of £10 which will be refunded if the complaint is upheld.
- Horses / Ponies must be 4 years or over in all ridden classes.
- Stallions and colts must be handled by a person over 16 and under control at all times.
- Timings of classes are approximate. It is the competitors responsibility to ensure that they arrive on time.
- Correctly secured hard hats with a strap to the current standard must be worn by all persons riding on the showground.
- Competitors must be correctly and appropriately attired for entry to classes.
- Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.

Class 1 – Junior's 13 & Under Team Showjumping

Max height of fences 75cms. Ponies must be 148cms & under riders not to have attained their 14th birthday

Class 2 – Under 16's Team Showjumping

Max height of fences 85cms. Ponies must be 148cms & under riders not to have attained their 17th birthday.

Class 3 – Junior / Under 16's Open Showjumping (Individual Class 3 entries per club)

Max height of fences 95cms. Ponies must be 148cms & under.

Class 4 – Senior Team Showjumping

Max height of fences 75 cms. Horses must be 148cms & over riders must have attained their 13th birthday.

Class 5 – Senior Team Showjumping

Max height of fences 85cms. Horses must be 148cms & over riders must have attained their 13th birthday.

Class 6 – Senior Open Showjumping (Individual Class 3 entries per club)

Max height of fences 95 cms. Riders must of attained there 13th birthday.

Class 7 – Puissance Wall
